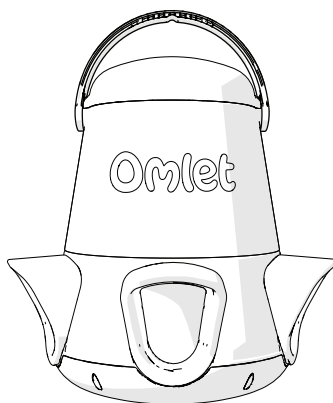


Locating your feeder:

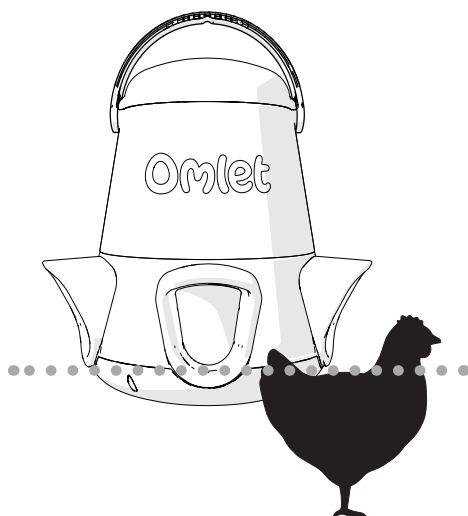


**Assemble with legs -
position on level ground.**

or



**Hang securely from weight
bearing structure and hanger.**

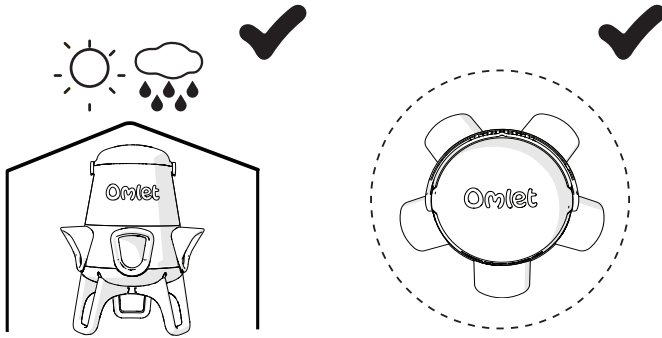


If hanging, set the base of the ports to match the height of your smallest chicken's back. This will give you optimum anti-spill.

EN: Warning: Positioning on the ground without legs will impact spill rate, this is not recommended. **NOT SUITABLE FOR CHICKS.**



Feeder positioning:



The Feeder should be placed under cover e.g. in your chicken run.
Ensure plenty of space around your Feeder so chickens can access all ports.

DOs

- Only use dry chicken feed e.g. pellets, crumble.
- Keep your feeder undercover to ensure food stays dry.
- Place your feeder on the stand provided or hang from the handle at an appropriate height for your chickens.
- Regularly monitor the feed level and general condition of the feeder.
- Clean your feeder regularly with a tap, hose or damp cloth.

DON'Ts

- Use wet or moist food or liquids.
- Keep your feeder unsheltered.
- Place your feeder in direct sunlight.
- Place your feeder directly on the floor without the stand.
- Expose the feeder to temperatures above 40°C or below -20°C.
- Place your feeder in a dishwasher.
- Put any more than 12lbs / 5.5kg of food in your feeder.
- Use your feeder without the rain hoods as they provide protection from rain and food spill.

More information:
