EN Important Information! Please read before use

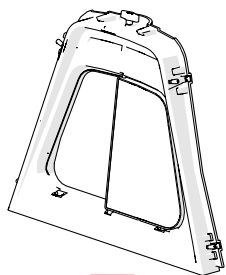
Some components are made from metal and the coating may need maintenance over time. We recommend regularly rinsing with potable water, especially if you live in an area that is coastal. If rust spots do develop, repair the area. If unsure how to do this, seek professional advice. With all self assembled systems, it is vital that the equipment is checked regularly and often by an adult. You should regularly check all screws and connections of the system to ensure no components become loose, worn or damaged. Should there be any missing, worn or damaged parts, the system must not be used until replacement parts have been fitted. Failure to do this may result in the product malfunctioning and causing injury.

DOs

- Make sure your chickens always have access to food and clean water.
- Supervise children when they are using the Eglu Go or interacting with the chickens.
- Wash your hands thoroughly after coming in contact with the Eglu Go or Chickens.
- Collect and enjoy your eggs everyday. Leaving eggs in the Eglu Go can cause your chicken to go broody and not lay any eggs for a few weeks.
- Let your chickens out of the Eglu Go everyday. If you are away, then leave the Eglu Go door open so that the chickens can get out into the run in the morning. Not letting your chickens out will lead to distressed chickens and could lead to terminal overheating.

DON'Ts

- Don't let children inside the Eglu Go. This could lead to them getting stuck.
- Don't use bleach, solvents or strong detergent to clean the Eglu Go, they could damage the plastic.
- Don't keep the Eglu Go near sources of ignition, such as a bonfire or barbecue, because they could set the Eglu Go on fire.
- Don't use the Eglu Go for anything other than housing chickens. It has not been designed for any other purpose.
- Don't keep more than 2-3 heavy breeds, 3 medium sized breeds or 4-5 small breeds in the Eglu Go.
