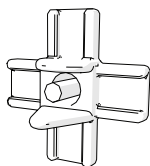
Getting to know your Waterer:



Cups or Nipples?



- We recommend using cups if your chickens are not already used to nipples.
- The automatically filling cups allow for easy drinking.

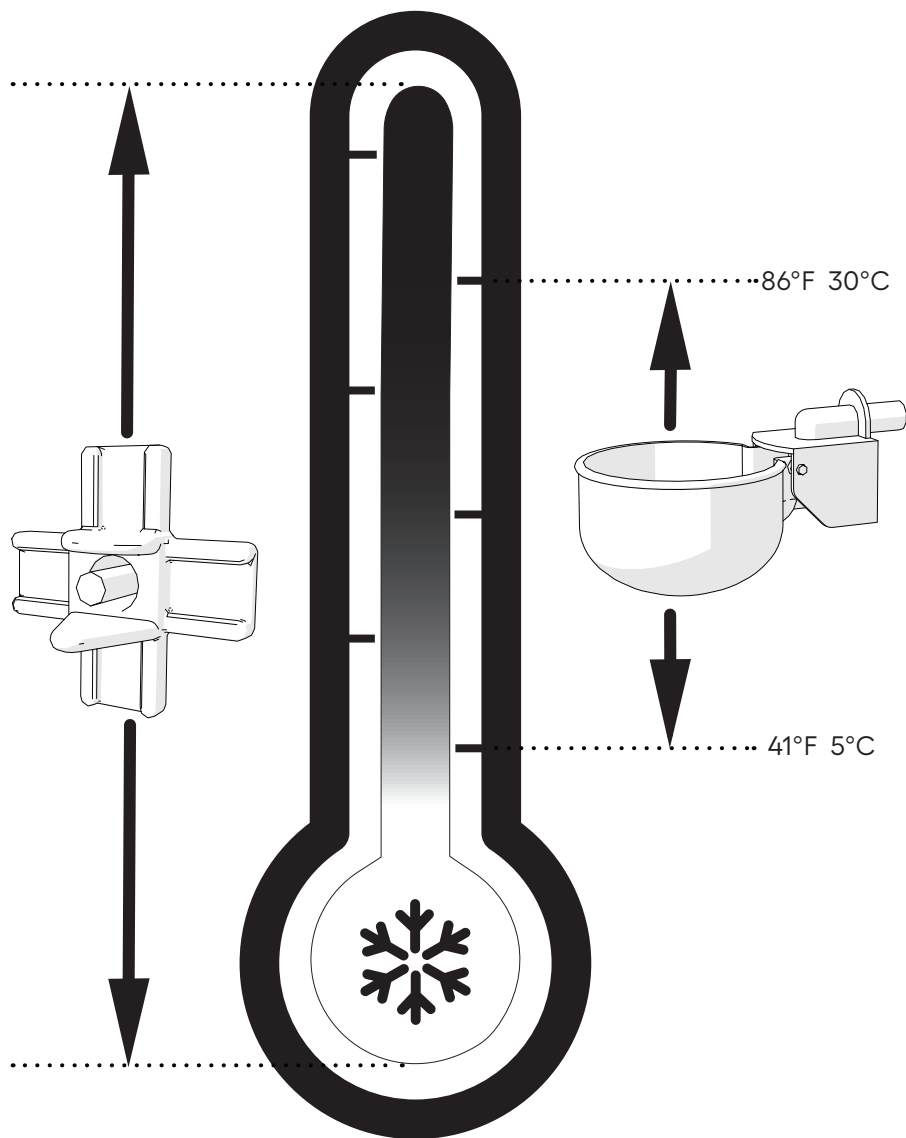


- Nipples are a reliable way of providing drinking water to your chickens in more extreme temperature ranges.
- Chickens may need time to learn how to use them.

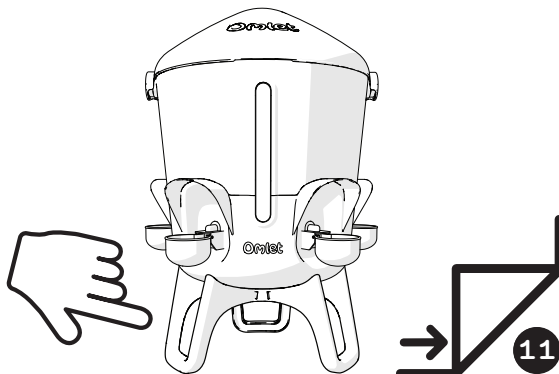


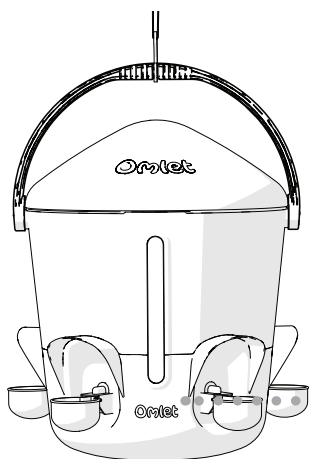
Ready to hang.



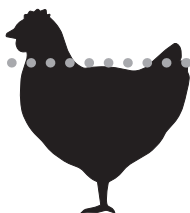
Hang securely from weight bearing structure. See page 10 for height recommendations.

Or attach legs.

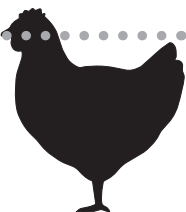




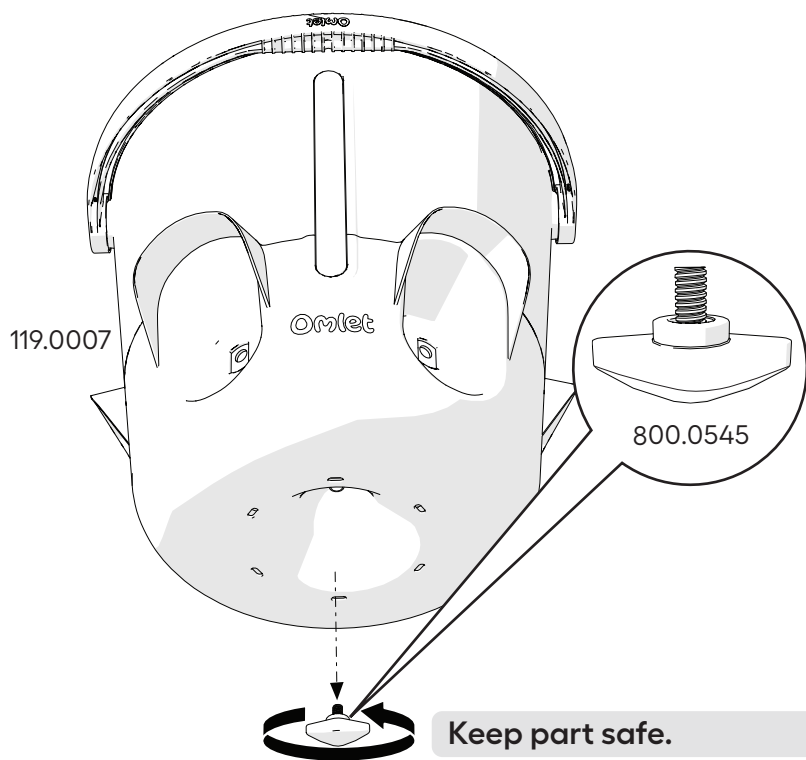
Cups should match the height of your smallest chicken's back.

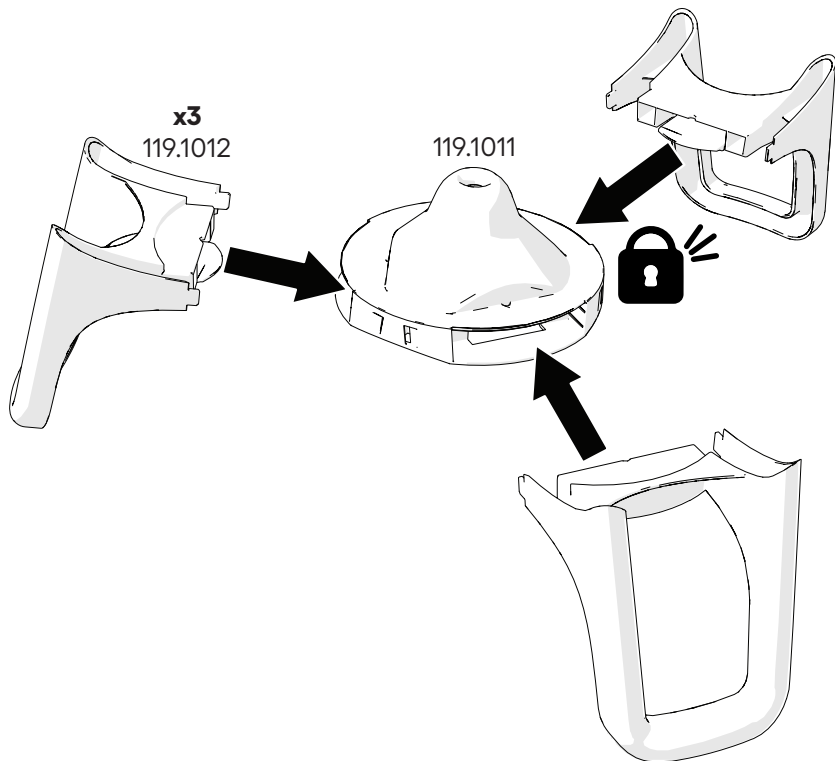


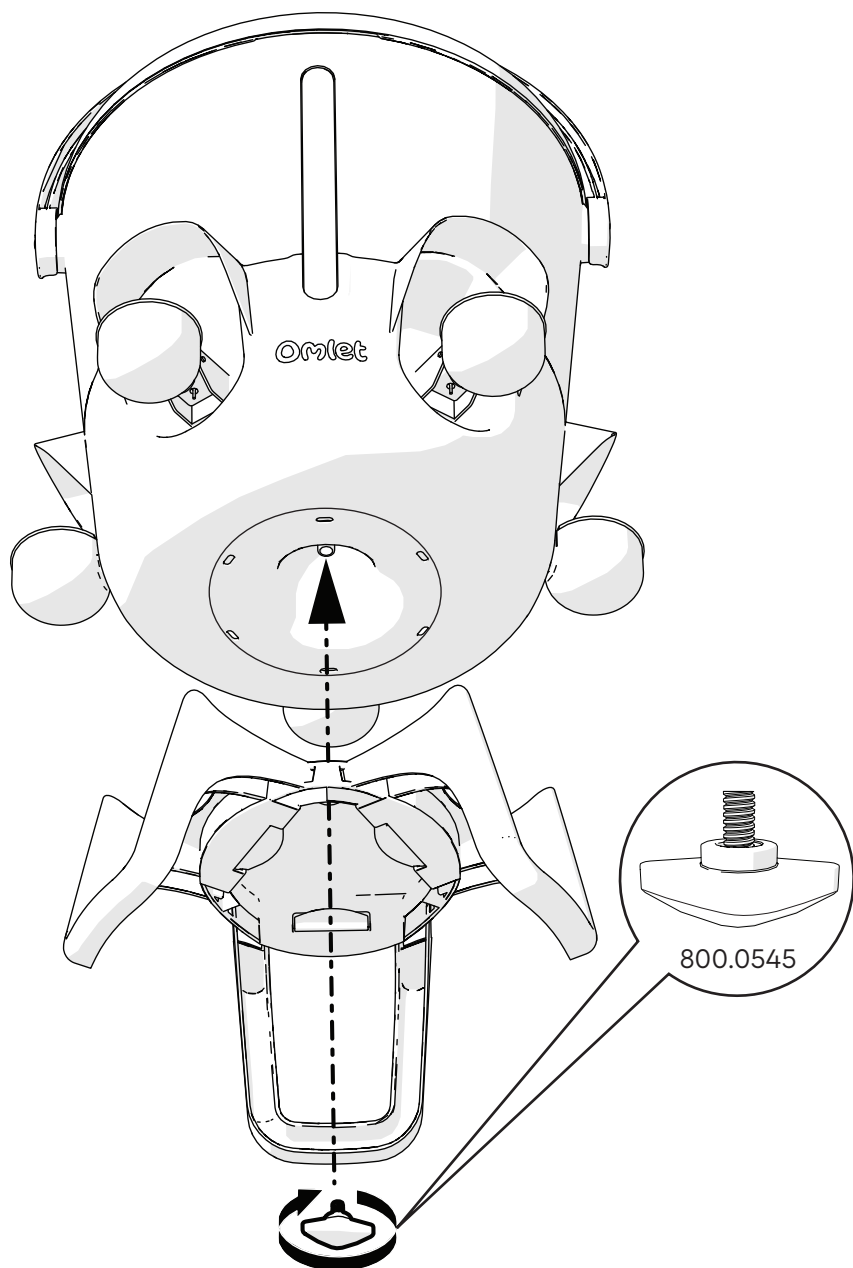
Nipples should match the height of your smallest chicken's beak.



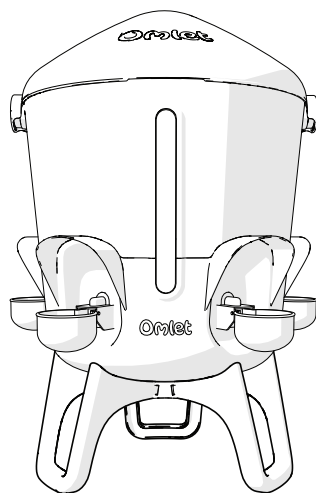

Ready to use:

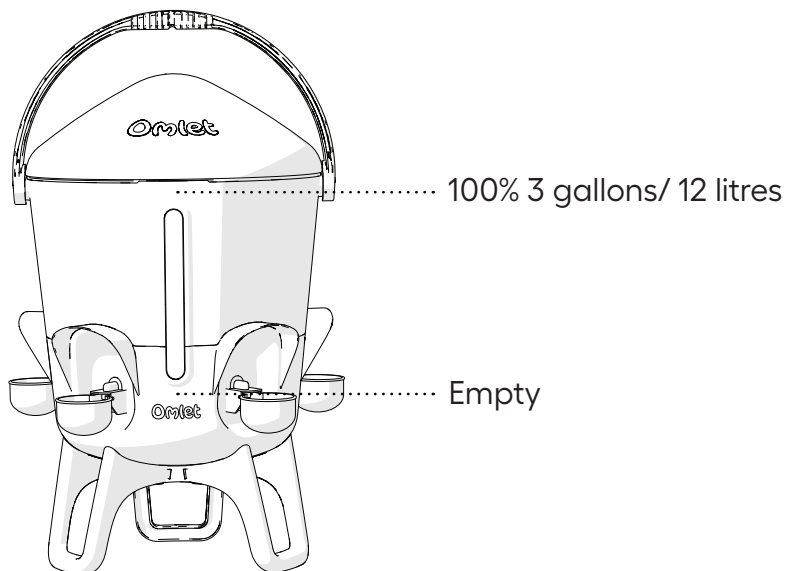


Position on level ground.

Positioning on the ground without a stand will compromise stability so is not recommended.
NOT SUITABLE FOR CHICKS.



Water level indicator:



WARNING - Water needs to be filled higher than the port holes to be accessible for your chickens.



Use a cloth to clean cups thoroughly or use a watering can or hose to quickly remove debris from cups.

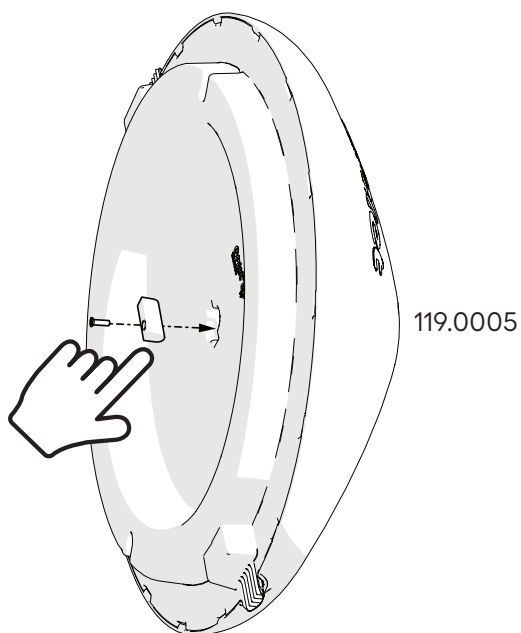
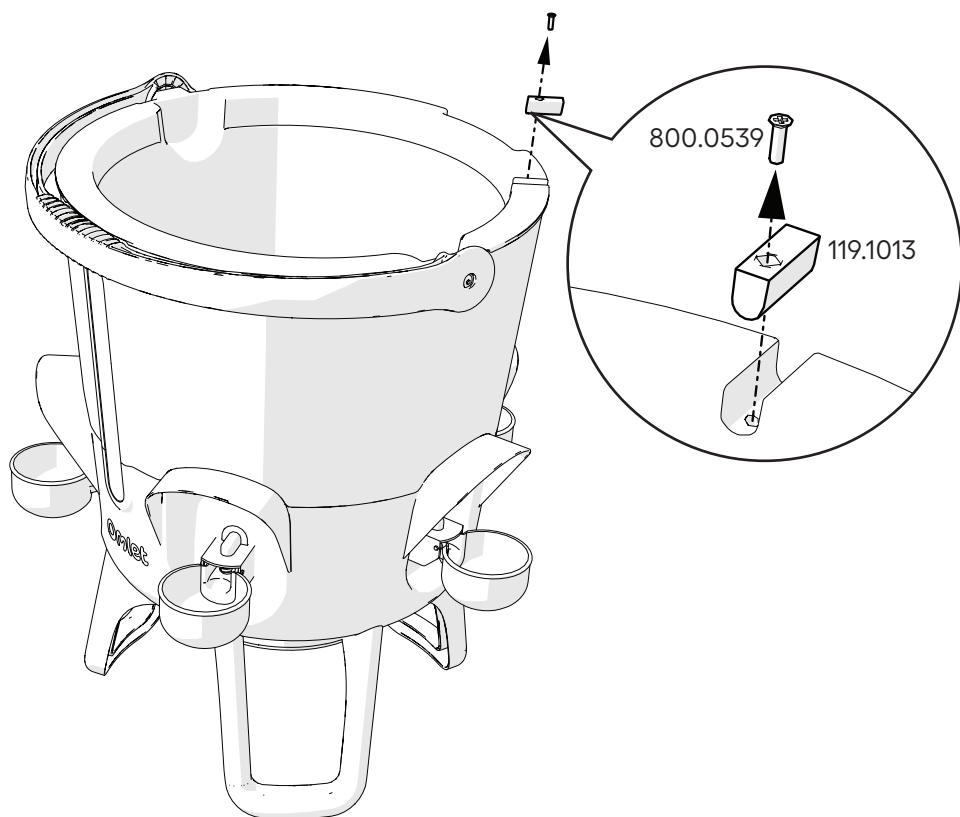




Adding a heater:

You will need...





DOs

- Fill waterer with clean fresh water.
- Ensure waterer is on flat level ground.
- Keep the lid locked when in use.
- Clean your waterer regularly with a tap, hose or damp cloth.
- Use pet safe cleaning products.
- Regularly monitor the water level and general condition of the waterer.
- Place the waterer on the stand provided or hang from the handle at an appropriate height for your chickens.

DON'Ts

- Overtighten wing nuts on nipples/cups.
- Place waterer in a dishwasher.
- Fill with hot or boiling water.
- Place in direct sunlight.
- Store upside down as water can fill up the insulated layer.
- Use chemicals or boiling water to clean.
- Use cups in extreme temperatures.
- Empty waterer when frozen inside. Ice can damage ports. Bring inside to melt ice completely, then empty.
